What is Payroll Giving?

Payroll Giving is a convenient and simple way to support The Salvation Army.

As an employee, payroll giving enables you to make a regular donation to The Salvation Army directly from your pre-tax pay. This means that you receive an immediate tax credit.

Payroll Giving also eliminates the need to collect receipts and wait until the end of the tax year to claim the tax credit for your donations.

How does it work?

Payroll Giving works by taking your regular donation to The Salvation Army directly from your pre-tax pay, via your organisation's payroll system.

You receive immediate tax credits that reduce PAYE amounts payable. Tax credits are calculated at 33.33 cents for each dollar donated.

Example

Karen makes a regular Payroll Giving donation to The Salvation Army. She is paid \$1,530 every two weeks. This is her only job, so her tax code is "M".
